This guide provides a list of dance journals that are currently subscribed to by Cook Library. In most cases, you can view these journals right on your desk top. To see a few titles, you may need to visit Cook Library.

Journals in Print Format

Print journals that are bound are shelved in the stacks under a call number, just like a book. To find the call number of a journal, check the **Journal List** link inside the Quick Search box on the library web page, or search by journal title in the library catalog. Journal issues that are loose (not yet bound) are located on the second floor of the library in the **Periodicals Reading Room**, on your right as you enter the doors. There is a Periodicals Service Desk with staff ready to assist you, if you need help.

Journals may not be checked out and must be used within Cook Library. There are photocopiers on all floors of Cook Library if you wish to make a copy of an article. Please be aware of copyright regulations as you photocopy any material from these journals.

On Campus Electronic Access

Follow this path from the Cook Library web page to see these journals:
Click on **Journal List** in **Quick Search** box. Go to **Search by Subject Category** – scroll to **Music, Dance, Drama, and Film** and click **Search**. From the result list, click on **Dance**.

To see articles in specific issues, click on the title of the database that holds the full text for years of the journal that you wish to see.

Off Campus Electronic Access

From the Cook Library web page – go to **Quick Tools - Off Campus Log-in**. Select **TU** as your institution and input your **14 digit borrower code** and your **last name** from your **TU OneCard** to log in. Click on the **Journals** tab. You won't see the same display of journal titles by subject, but you can type in the name of the specific dance journal you would like to see, and ResearchPort will connect you with issue access.

Dance Journals not Owned at TU

By using **ILLiad** (TU's interlibrary loan service), you can request copies of articles from dance journals that are not subscribed to by TU.



To request a book or article through Interlibrary Loan: On the **Cook Library Homepage**, go to: **Services** column – **Interlibrary Loan services** – Scroll to **ILLiad Log in** link and register for an **ILLiad account**.

Once you have registered, you can use the online forms in your account to request books, copies of journal articles, and more. You can also link directly to your ILLiad account from any database which uses a **Find it** button. From the **Find it** dialogue window, open the **"Request document through Interlibrary Loan"** link to open your **ILLiad account**. Logging in this way links to a partially completed ILL form. Fill in the remainder of the information and click the **Submit** button.
