

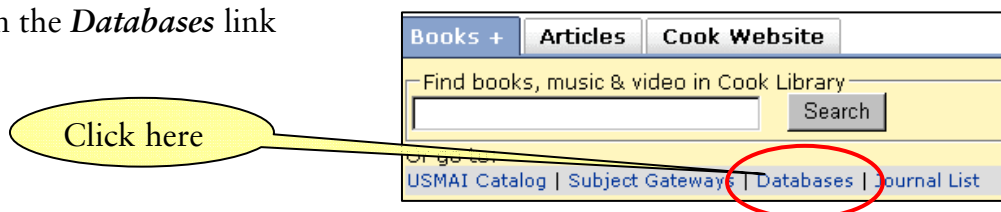
Wozworld Quick Guide to Library Research

Topic: Searching for E-books

Use this guide to search for e-books in the using the Ebrary/Academic Complete or Netlibrary databases. You can also access the e-book databases by clicking on a link to an e-book title listed in the Cook Library catalog.

Step 1. Go to the library web page at: <http://cooklibrary.towson.edu>

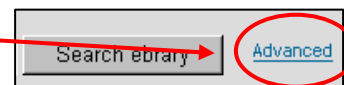
Step 2. Click on the *Databases* link



Step 3. From the A to Z list, choose either *Netlibrary* or *Ebrary/Academic Complete* database:



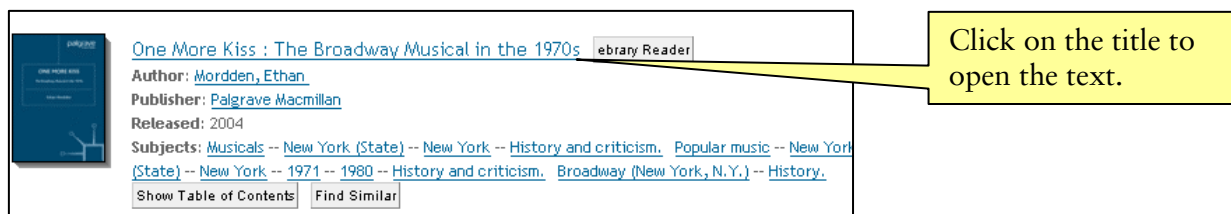
Step 4. In *Ebrary*, begin by clicking on *Advanced Search*.



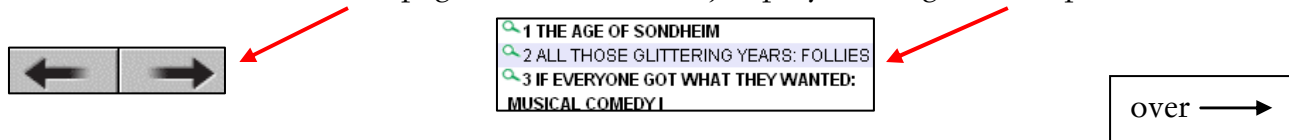
Step 5. Be sure search type is set to *Text and Key Fields*.



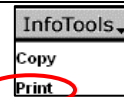
Step 6. From the result list, select a book to view.





Click on arrows to turn pages of the ebook or jump by clicking on a chapter title.



Use the *Info Tools* button to print 5 pages at a time.



For additional tools such as highlighting, note-taking, and full text searching, view the title in the *ebrary* Reader mode. Click on  to download the *ebrary* reader.

To save changes between sessions and to check this title out to your electronic *ebrary* book shelf, click on  to create a free account.


Step 7. *Netlibrary* does not have a very good search engine to find titles. To get any results, you need to search the *Netlibrary* database using very broad terms.

Try a *keyword* or *subject* search first

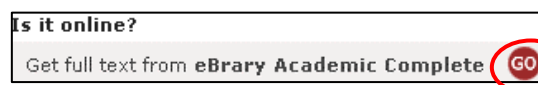
